## **Towne Harbour Island Beach and Fire Pit Guidelines**

- 1. Children under 18 years must be accompanied by a THI resident while the fire pit is in use.
- 2. Children 12 years and under must always be accompanied by a THI resident while at the beach area. THI residents are always responsible for the behavior and safety of their guest(s).
- 3. Please be considerate of your neighbors after 11:00 PM and remember that sound carries; no loud music or noise at the beach after that time.
- 4. No glassware or bottles are permitted in the beach area.
- 5. Carry in / carry out all trash, etc.
- 6. Pick up any food remnants since these will attract seagulls, geese and other animals.
- 7. Nothing is to be thrown into fire pit while it is on or off, such as wood, trash, cigarette butts, etc.
- 8. The last person at the fire pit is to turn it off and return the key to its original location.

## **Fire Pit Instructions**

- 1. Remove the key from its secure location using the combination you have been given or bring you own key.
- 2. Insert key into fire pit
- 3. Turn to the left 1/2 turn
- 4. Using a long lighter (you will need to bring with you), light the brass burner
- 5. Turn the key to the left (lake side) for higher flame
- 6. Turn the key to the right (inner circle) for lower flame
- 7. Turn key all the way to the right to turn off
- 8. Remove the key and return to its secure location and lock it
