Bulk will be removed at no additional fee on your regular pick-up day during the SECOND FULL week of the months indicated on the schedule to the left beginning on Monday's. Any trash or bulk put out after your regular pick up will incur a fee for collection.

NOTE: BULK PICKUP IS ONLY 9 MONTHS OUT OF THE CALENDAR YEAR.

BULK REFUSE PICK-UP - ** EXCLUDING ALL E-WASTE**
 Bulk refuse shall be defined as any item that is not enclosed within a container or bulk refuse shall include, but is not limited to furniture, bedding, carpeting, large household appliances, plumbing fixtures including hot water heaters and piping, sod, and wood debris. No Concrete, Bricks or Roofing Materials will be collected. Bulk materials shall only be placed at the curb for pick up on your regularly scheduled pick-up day during the second week of the months designated by the Town/Village Board upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Public Works. Bulk placed at the curb at any other time will be picked but the owner of the property will be subject to a fee to cover the cost of its removal. Effective June 1, 2019 bulk and trash can no longer be dropped off at the DPW Garage. It is illegal to bring refuse and recycling from property located outside of the Town/Village of East Rochester.

IMPORTANT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION
 Please place refuse and bulk at the curb no sooner than 6:00 pm on the day before your regular pick-up day. Any refuse or bulk put out in advance of this requirement will be removed and a charge may be levied against the property owner. All empty cans or containers must be removed within 12 hours after they are emptied. Place refuse in containers not to exceed 35 gallons or 50 pounds each. During designated weeks the cost of excessive amounts of bulk will be passed along to the property owner at the discretion of DPW.

LEAF & BRUSH REMOVAL
 DPW will conduct vacuum curbside pick up of leaf piles from approximately 10/1 to 12/15 depending on the weather. Do not place leaves in the road as they pose a hazard for children, create parking problems, and cause a back-up of the storm sewers. Residents are requested to bag leaves in RECYCLABLE PAPER BAGS and place them at the curb with your ordinary refuse on your regular scheduled pick-up day. Please do not place leaves in garbage cans. Grass clippings must also be in RECYCLABLE PAPER BAGS and placed at the curb on your regular scheduled pick-up day. Branches, shrubs, trees and other brush are normally picked-up each Monday.

Effective April 1, 2019 we will not collect leaves or yard waste in plastic bags.

TIRE REMOVAL
 All tires placed at the curb are subject to a fee for their disposal regardless of when they are discarded, including free bulk pick up weeks. The Town/Village is charged directly from the landfill a special disposal fee for all tires.

SPECIAL PICK-UP FEES - fines for non-compliance are as follows:
 \$25 for the first offense
 \$50 for the second offense
 \$75 for the third offense
 \$100 for the fourth and each additional offense thereafter

Note: excessive amount of bulk may result in additional fees regardless of how many offenses have occurred.

NEW E-WASTE UPDATE
 E-Waste cannot be placed out on bulk week or at anytime. Please read the back side of this document. This change went into effect 01/01/2023 and is known as the Electronic Equipment Recycling & Refuse Act(New York State Law).



***** **E-Waste Policy: Effective January 1, 2023** *****

New York State has changed the rules and regulations regarding E-Waste collection effective January 1, 2023. The Electronic Equipment Recycling & Refuse Act will be followed by the Town/Village of East Rochester at our disposal site located at 200 Ontario Street.

- There will be **No** charge to residents/businesses at our site
- We will accept all devices listed, i.e. tv's, computers, etc. (See list below)
- We are required to staff our secure collection site, no unattended drop off is permitted
- We will provide storage of items that is not exposed to weather

Examples of Electronic Waste (E-Waste) covered by the new law are: Computers including laptops, desktops, tablets & e-readers), Televisions, Cathode ray tubes. Computer peripherals (including any cable, card, or wiring accompanying the computer peripherals). Monitors, electronic keyboards, mice or similar pointing devices, facsimile machines, document scanners and printers (only those intended for use with a computer and weighing less than 100 lbs.) Small electronic equipment including any cable, card, or wiring accompanying the device. VCR's, DVR's, CD/DVD players, Digital converter boxes, Cable or satellite receivers, digital media receivers, Electronic or video game consoles, small scale servers.

All forms of E-Waste placed at the curb for collection during regular pick will incur a fee of \$25.00 per item if collected by the Department of Public Works (DPW). E-Waste items that have CRT's will also be incurring a \$25.00-dollar fee per item.

To avoid the fee for curbside collection, any residents wishing to dispose of any approved electronic waste, may instead bring their items to the Department of Public Works Garage at 200 Ontario Street. Residents should first call the DPW at 585-381-1565 to schedule an appointment to drop off such items, Monday through Thursday, 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Although residents will be asked to sign in for this process, there is no fee for this drop off service and it is available to all residents regardless of whether they have refuse service provided by the Town/Village of East Rochester. Anyone dropping off unacceptable items will be subject to fines.
